As a condition of accepting your University offer you must also declare any unspent relevant criminal convictions, to be dealt with under the University's policy. You will receive a separate email from the University explaining how and when to do this by mid-January and also giving details of someone to contact if you need any help or guidance.

This will include a college contract, which you will be asked to sign and return as a condition of entry.
